Buchanan, Mr	Asked to inspect the school paintwork in 1934

Crossland, Miss Gertrude	Employed as a “act.50” 1907
Curry, Mr	Local tradesman from Sherburn
Day, Mr A.	School Manager 1934-
Dickinson, Mrs L.D.	Headmistress 1931-

Dickson, Miss Emily	Employed as a “act.50” in 1904, and later as a teacher 1904-1908
Dobson, Miss Emily	Employed as a “a.68” 1904
Dobson, Miss Isabella	Teacher arrived prior to 1903, resigned 1904
Dobson, Mr	Local tradesman from Staxton, used to repair brickwork at the school in 1915
Dobson, Mrs	School Cleaner 1903-1904
Edison, Mr Charles	Architect employed by the managers to draw up their plans for enlargement of the school (1912)
Firman, Mr Charles Osbaldeston	Chairman of the School Managers 1903-1911

Jeffreys, Mrs	School Cleaner 1921-?
Joch, Mr G.R.B	HM School Inspector who inspected the school in 1934
Kedge, Mrs	School Cleaner 1928-?
King & Co.	Ironmongers based in Hull that provided oil lamps to the school

Knight, Miss Mabel	Employed as a “act.50” 1907-1908
Lait, Miss M.G.	Teacher 1908-1909
Legard, Lady	Wife of Sir Algernon Willoughby Legard
Legard, Rev Cecil	Contacted to ask him to consider transferring Ganton School to Church ownership in 1910
Legard, Sir Algernon Willoughby	Local landowner, and the owner of the Ganton School until 1911
Leng, Miss M.H	Teacher 1923-1930
Macharness, Archdeacon	Asked for his advice about enlarging the school & raising the funds for doing so in 1908
